

Action: 11 **A Health Stakeholders Forum will be set up to improve co-ordination between the Local Health Office areas Dublin North West and Dublin North, local Elected Members, other State Agencies and the Community Sector.**

Rationale Reformed Health Service Executive structures have limited consultation structure with representative and participative democracy systems. Significant public health gains are possible if Community Development structures and groups engage with the new HSE. Co-ordinated projects between Local Health Offices and other state-funded bodies will increase the health gain for the people of Fingal. The Public Health Objectives identified in Improved Cohesion can be addressed by the Forum.
