

Action: 13 A joint Policing Countywide Committee will be set up subject to legislation and funding.

Rationale The Garda Síochána Bill, when enacted will contain provisions for the establishment of Joint Policing Committees and Local Policing Forums. These multi-sectoral representative structures will have a key role to play in preventing crime and disorder at a local level, leading to more effective targeting of resources in tackling issues of crime, disorder and anti social behaviour.
